Residency Policy  
Board Adopted 2006

The TRCS Administrator is responsible for making a good faith determination that a student meets the residency requirements of our contract with WLWV. This may be accomplished initially by having parents sign an affirmative statement annually upon enrollment that they meet the definition of a resident as defined by WLWV.

The administrator will take reasonable steps to verify a student's residency upon receiving information that questions that student's residency.

Should a student be determined by the administrator not to meet the residency requirements, that student will be required to leave TRCS at the next appropriate break in the academic calendar, as determined by the TRCS Administrator.

In the event that removal of the non-resident student lowers the school enrollment below 100, the administrator will offer the opening to the next student on the waiting list. Should the vacancy occur after March of the academic calendar, the offer of admittance to the student on the waiting list may be made for matriculation at the start of the next academic year, upon agreement of the administrator and the student/parents.
